

Instrument of Government: St John's Mead C of E.V.C primary school

- 1. The name of the school is St John's Mead C of E.V.C primary school**
- 2. The school is a Voluntary controlled school**
- 3. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of St Johns Mead C of E.V.C primary school"**
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:**
 - 4 Parent governors**
 - 2 LEA governors**
 - 2 Staff governors**
 - 1 Community governors**
 - 3 Foundation governors**
- 5. Total number of governors 12**
- 6. Foundation governors shall be appointed by the Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education after consultation with St. John the Baptist Parochial church Council**
- 7 The holder of the following shall be a foundation governor ex-officio:**
 - a, The principle officiating minister of the ecclesiastical parish of Chipping Sodbury ?**
 - b, The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall, on behalf of Gloucester Diocesan board of education, be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex-officio governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 23(2) of the regulations**
- 8. The person named in paragraph 7b above shall be entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute foundation governor.**
- 9. St John's Mead Church of England controlled School has a Christian foundation which it seeks to translate into practices which influence the life of the school and the lives of the pupils. It serves the parish of Sodbury and surrounding areas and aims to provide high quality education within the context of Christian faith and practice. It promotes an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and seeks to encourage Christian standards**

and values through the quality of experience which it provides for all its pupils and the examples it sets them.

10. The term of office of governors is 4 years. (This does not apply to the Head master or the ex-officio foundation governor)
