

Spring Term 1 - Spelling Homework

Below are your child's spellings for this term. We expect the children to practise their spelling at home each week. They should use the 'look, say, cover, write, check' method that we use in school and copy out the spellings at least 3 times in their spelling books. In addition they could create sentences using the spellings; they may make up their own or you could dictate sentences to them. This is also an opportunity for children to practise their handwriting.

The new curriculum states that children are required to be able to spell a list of words by the end of each year. Every week, the words in bold are taken from the year 3 and 4 spelling list or high frequency word list. We will test the children on their spellings every Friday, as shown in the table below **Please ensure your child has their spelling book with them every Friday.**
