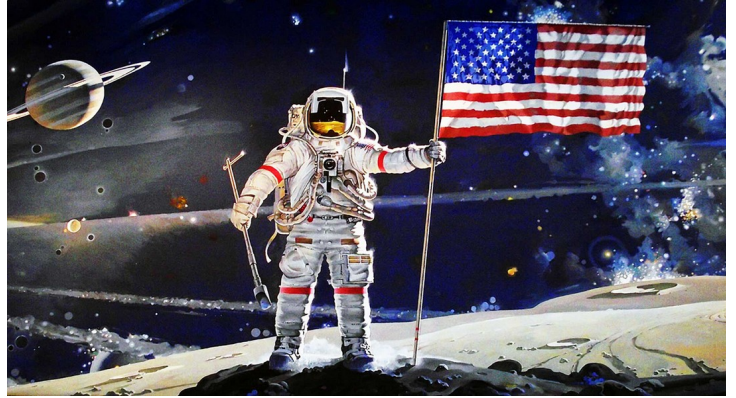


# SPACE MAGAZINE

- Week 1 (12/1/17): Design and create a front cover of the magazine inspired by the work of our focus artist, Robert T McCall (see picture above).
- Week 2 (19/1/17): Create an information page about the planets of the solar system.
- Week 3 (26/1/17): Write a fact file focusing on information about one of the planets.
- Week 4 (2/2/17): Using the attached information, children pick one of the scientists we have looked at and write a diary entry describing their ideas about Planetary Motion.
- Week 5 (9/2/17): Write a page which answers the question: Why do we have Night and Day?

**Half Term (Hand in what you have done so far on Monday 20th February)**

- Week 6 (23/2/17): Create an information page explaining the seasons and why we have them.
- Week 7 (2/3/17): Explain the different phases of the Moon and why it is that we see it differently throughout the month.
- Week 8 (9/3/17): Write a story inspired by Space.
- Week 9 (16/3/17): Create a fact file about an astronaut.
- Week 10 (23/3/17): Create a puzzle or quiz related to Space and any finishing touches to the magazine e.g. contents page.
- Week 11 (30/3/17): Create a free gift to go on the front of the magazine
